As we move towards the summer term and continue along the 'roadmap' to normality, it is likely that some Covid measures will ease with time. The school is keen to find ways to enable the children to enjoy the activities and events, whilst remaining safe, that they would normally participate in at the appropriate times of the school year.

In summer term 2, the Year 5 / 6 pupils would normally rehearse and prepare for their end of year performance. This year it will be Lion King. In July 2020, the school rebooked Bishop

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Monkton Village Hall for summer 2021 in the hope that there would be the possibility of a normal performance with an audience. Audiences are currently not permitted. So, the school is trying to preserve the experience of performing on a stage for the Class 4 children and we intend to take Class 4 to Bishop Monkton Village Hall in order to film the performance even if audiences are still not permitted in July. Therefore, we are looking for a local (ish) company which would professionally film the Class 4 performance so that we may share this with their families afterwards.
